EACH APPLICANT, PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION.

1. If you are planning a fall admission (in September), the Scholarship Committee must receive your completed application no later than **May 15th**.
2. If you are planning a spring admission/renewal (in January), the Scholarship Committee must receive your completed application/renewal no later than **November 15th**.
3. Upon approval of your application, the disbursement of funds will be made to you when you have provided a copy of your paid tuition bill to the Scholarship Committee. If a copy of your paid tuition bill has not been provided to the Scholarship Committee by **October 15th** and **February 15th**, funds will not be available.
4. A full application must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee for each **September admission by May 15th**. When the disbursement is made (for September), you will receive a Request for Scholarship Renewal for your next semester session.
5. Your completed application, request for renewal and other documents can be forwarded to the attention of the Scholarship Committee. All information will be held confidential.
6. Please feel free to contact the Scholarship Committee with any questions you may have. We will be glad to help you.

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Rules Governing Scholarships

1. Individuals applying for scholarships must have two (2) years membership in the church and be an active worker in the church program.
2. A written application is required by the applicant, which may be obtained from the Scholarship Committee.
3. Individuals applying may attend a trade school, religious school, college or post graduate school leading to or receiving a certificate, diploma or degree.
4. Recipients attending college leading to a degree can apply for a maximum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) semi-annually.
5. Applicants attending any other post secondary school, leading to a certificate or diploma, can apply for a maximum of one hundred and twenty-five (\$125.00) per year.
6. Part-time college students in a degree program (minimum of six (6) course credit hours) can apply for a scholarship. The maximum allowance is one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00) per semester for a period not to exceed ten (10) semesters.
7. No individual shall receive in excess of one thousand two hundred (\$1200.00) in total scholarship funds.
8. There is no age limit for applicants.
9. Fall semester applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by **May 15th**. Requests for the spring semester must be made by **November 15th** each year.
10. Individuals must provide to the Scholarship Committee a copy of their paid tuition statement for each semester prior to receiving a disbursement.

Financing

1. The Scholarship Committee fund is supported through church contributions. Individual contributions are accepted at any time.
2. Programs to support the Scholarship Fund will be indicated on the church calendar.
3. The church will be notified of those who receive scholarships at the church meeting.
4. Upon recommendation of the Scholarship Committee, the Trustee Board will disburse all funds to the treasurer of the Scholarship Committee for distribution.

The Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for the **Claudine Vicks Scholarship**. An award of at least five hundred dollars (\$500) will be given to a qualified student to use toward further his/her education. Mrs. Vicks was a faithful member of Nazarene for over 50 years. She served the Scholarship Committee and the youth of our church with dedication during her entire lifetime.

To qualify each applicant must:

- Be a member of Nazarene Baptist Church for minimum of two years.
- Be a graduating high school senior for the current year.

To apply, each applicant must:

- Type an essay of 400 – 500 words on the following topic:
“What a College Education Would Mean to Me”
- Include in your essay how you hope to make a difference after graduation and how you see yourself carrying out this mission in your professional and/or personal life.

Deadline

- Completed applications and essay must be received no later than April 30th.
- Interviews will be scheduled no later than May 15th.
- Award will be announced the fourth Sunday of June – “Graduate Recognition Day”.

Judging

- Essays will be judged by the Scholarship Committee on content, grammar, expression and overall impact.

Disbursement

- Monies will be dispersed when proof of matriculation is received by the Scholarship Committee.
