EACH APPLICANT, PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION.

1. If you are planning a fall admission/renewal (in September), the Scholarship Committee must receive your completed application/renewal no later than **May 15th**.
2. If you are planning a spring admission/renewal (in January), the Scholarship Committee must receive your completed application/renewal no later than **November 15th**.
3. Upon approval of your application, the disbursement of funds will be made to you when you have provided a copy of your paid tuition bill to the Scholarship Committee. If a copy of your paid tuition bill has not been provided to the Scholarship Committee by **October 15th** and **February 15th**, funds will not be available.
4. A full application must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee for each **September admission by May 15th**. When the disbursement is made (for September), you will receive a Request for Scholarship Renewal for your next semester session.
5. Your completed application, request for renewal and other documents can be forwarded to the attention of the Scholarship Committee. All information will be held confidential.
6. Please feel free to contact the Scholarship Committee with any questions you may have. We will be glad to help you.

Rules Governing Scholarships

1. Individuals applying for scholarships must have two (2) years membership in the church and be an active worker in the church program.
2. A written application is required by the applicant, which may be obtained from the Scholarship Committee.
3. Individuals applying may attend a trade school, religious school, a college or post graduate school leading to or receiving of a certificate, a diploma, or a degree.
4. Recipients attending college leading to a degree can apply for a maximum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) semi-annually.
5. Applicants attending any other post-secondary schools, leading to a certificate or diploma can apply for a maximum of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per year.
6. Part-time college students in a degree program (minimum of six (6) course credit hours) can apply for a scholarship. The maximum allowance is one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00) per semester for a period not to exceed ten (10) semesters.
7. No individual shall receive in excess of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00) in total scholarship funds.
8. There is no age limit for applicants.
9. Applications and proof of enrollment must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by October 15th for fall admissions and February 15th for the spring admissions.
10. Individuals must provide to the scholarship committee, proof of enrollment for each semester prior to the disbursement of funds. (Official class schedule, academic verification letter or paid/ partially paid tuition statement.)
11. If you are not enrolled in classes for two consecutive semesters or one full year or change schools, you will be required to complete a new application and provide proof of enrollment.

FINANCING

1. The Scholarship fund is supported through church contributions. Individual contributions are accepted at any time.
2. Programs to support the scholarship Fund will be indicated on the church calendar.
3. The church will be notified of those who receive scholarships at church meetings.

The Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for the **Claudine Vicks Scholarship**. An award of at least five hundred dollars (\$500) will be given to a qualified student to use toward further his/her education. Mrs. Vicks was a faithful member of Nazarene for over 50 years. She served the Scholarship Committee and the youth of our church with dedication during her entire lifetime.

To qualify each applicant must:

- Be a member of Nazarene Baptist Church for minimum of two years.
- Be a graduating high school senior for the current year.

To apply, each applicant must:

- Type an essay of 400 – 500 words on the following topic:
“What a College Education Would Mean to Me”
- Include in your essay how you hope to make a difference after graduation and how you see yourself carrying out this mission in your professional and/or personal life.

Deadline

- Completed applications and essay must be received no later than April 30th.
- Interviews will be scheduled no later than May 15th.
- Award will be announced the fourth Sunday of June – “Graduate Recognition Day”.

Judging

- Essays will be judged by the Scholarship Committee on content, grammar, expression and overall impact.

Disbursement

- Monies will be dispersed when proof of matriculation is received by the Scholarship Committee.
